Job training programs include construction administration and hotel hospitality.

Toolworks	25 Kearny St (btwn Post and Geary), #400, 94108 415-733-0990 M-F 8:30am-4:30pm	Job support and placement; offers a 10-12 week janitorial training program. People with disabilities are eligible for services.
Goodwill Industries of San Francisco	1500 Mission St (@ 11 <sup>th</sup> ), 94103 415-575-2101 M-F 8am-5pm	Job training programs designed to help people overcome obstacles to employment. Training includes paid work experience in one of Goodwill's divisions, truck driving instruction, welfare-to-work support for CalWORKS and PAES participants (must be referred by Department of Human Services), and job assistance to homeless, veterans, and ex-offenders.
St. Anthony Foundation - Employment Program/Learning Center	55 Jones (btwn Golden Gate and McAllister), 94102 415-592-2766 M 8am-12:30pm, Tu-F 8am-3:30pm	Offers courses in basic literacy, computer skills, GED preparation, life skills, and individual tutoring. Services also include assistance with job placement and retention. St. Anthony's also offers a Computer Internship Program that trains participants towards obtaining a computer technician certification.

Arriba Juntos	1850 Mission St (btwn 14 <sup>th</sup> and 15 <sup>th</sup> ), 94103 415-487-3240 M-F 8:30am-5pm	Job training programs prepare participants for work in health care, transportation, administration, and other non-profit agencies. Offers courses taught in Spanish, in addition to an ESL program. Upon completion of the job training programs, AJ assists participants with job placement. Placement Center is equipped with job search resources and Internet access for employment purposes. Open to the public.
Episcopal Community Services – The Skills Center	165 8th St (btwn Mission and Howard), 3rd Floor, 94103 415-487-3333 M-F 1pm-5pm	Offers classes in GED preparation, adult literacy, and computer skills. Students also have access to housing services, mental health support, and recovery programs. The vocational training program offers individual job support and retention services. Offers a 12-week CHEFS program (Conquering Homelessness through Employment in Food Service), which is followed by a 12-week internship and job placement.
Senior Ex-Offender Program	1706 Yosemite Ave (@ 3 <sup>rd</sup> ), 94124 415-593-8235	Services include counseling, support groups, education, health care, housing, and employment support.
Central City Hospitality House – Employment Program	290 Turk St (@ Leavenworth), 94102 415-749-2100 M-F 9am-5pm	Resource Center is equipped with computers, Internet access, faxes, phones, and resume assistance to those seeking employment. 3-week workshop prepares participants for job interviews and employment, and upon completion, participants receive a \$50 gift certificate for the purchase of professional attire. 6-week computer classes are offered in collaboration with Network Ministries and include a \$30 weekly stipend contingent on regular attendance and successful completion. Services also include job placement, counseling, and retention services.
Glide – Training and Employment Services	330 Ellis St (btwn Taylor and Jones), 94102 415-674-6000	Services include GED preparation, pre-apprenticeship construction courses, job skills training, job placement, and certification programs for adults ages 17-24 years old.
